

SOMERSET - SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

The SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK hours of the Somerset pool now provides Swim & Tennis Members longer pool hours and access to the pool when no lifeguard is on duty. It is the responsibility of each Member to abide by the rules and pool time scheduled as outlined below. Anyone violating these guidelines will be denied access to the pool facilities for the remainder of the season and charged a \$50 fine.

Following are the 2010 Swim at Your Own Risk rules and regulations. A new security lock with a magnetic card reader has been installed on the inside pool doors (numeric code is still required for outer doors), and cards are activated only for the hours listed below. There will be no access to the pool without an active card. Cards will be issued one per family for a one-time fee of \$25. If card is lost, an additional \$25 is required to replace the card.

- *If you wish to obtain a card, please print, sign and return this form - **along with a check for \$25 made payable to SHOA** - to the pool co-chairs during designated issuance times, and you will then be issued an active card for gaining pool access during Swim at Your Own Risk hours.*

SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK RULES:

1. Somerset Swim & Tennis Members and their children will be allowed to use the pool without a lifeguard during stated Swim at Your Own Risk hours. Please note, **an adult member MUST be present with children (18 years and younger) and their guests - no exceptions.** Anyone violating this rule will have their access card deactivated, will be suspended from the pool for the remainder of the season and the family of the unsupervised child will be fined \$50.
2. Each person is responsible for cleaning up and removing their trash, putting the chairs back around the tables and putting the umbrellas down.
3. Swim at Your Own Risk official swimming hours: 7am - 4pm and 8pm - 10pm, Monday thru Friday and 7am - 10am and 9pm - 10pm Saturday and Sunday beginning August 5, 2010. **No one is allowed in the pool area after 10pm- no exceptions.** Anyone violating this rule will have their access card deactivated, will be suspended from the pool for the remainder of the season and will be fined \$50.
4. Upon leaving, members must swipe their magnetic card to record the time they left.
5. Parties may NOT be held at the pool during Swim At Your Own Risk Hours, only during normal operating hours and must be coordinated with SwimAtlanta.
6. Normal pool rules remain in effect during Swim at Your Own Risk hours. This includes no running, pushing or horseplay, no pets, or glassware allowed in the pool area. Also, no bicycles, skateboards or scooters are allowed.
7. **Non-potty-trained children must wear a swim diaper AND rubber pants.** A tight fitting bathing suit is required over the diaper. SwimAtlanta and Sherridan Santivaney (770-859-0538) must be called if a fecal "accident" happens and the pool must be shut down for a period of 24 hours for treatment.

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8. The lifeguard stand is off limits during swim at your own risk hours. The lifeguard stand is for lifeguard use only and is off limits to pool members. - **no exceptions.**
9. Residents of Somerset who are not Swim & Tennis members **may not** be guests at the pool, nor other current Swim & Tennis members who have not signed up for Swim at Your Own Risk cards. Per pool rules, guests must live more than 5 miles from the pool and must be accompanied by pool members at all times.
10. Please keep your card in a safe place and do not share with others. All members entering the pool must have signed this waiver in order to swim without lifeguards present.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK RULES AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I have read and understand the attached Somerset "Swim at Your Own Risk" rules and agree hereby to abide by such rules. I understand and agree that if I or any member of my family or guest violates a rule, knowingly or otherwise, then the SHOA Board may, at its discretion, deny my family and me access to the pool for the remainder of the then current pool season as well as the imposition of a \$50 fine. In addition, I understand that "Swim at Your Own Risk" is a time during which the SHOA has determined that there will be no lifeguard or other person available for the aid of swimmers. Therefore, if my family, guests or I elect to utilize the pool during such period then we do so at our own risk. **Accordingly, I, on behalf of myself and my family and guests, agree to hold harmless and release Somerset Home Owners Association (SHOA) and all its Directors, Officers and/or Committee Chairpersons from any and all liability and damages during "Swim at Your Own Risk" hours as set forth in the attached rules.**
